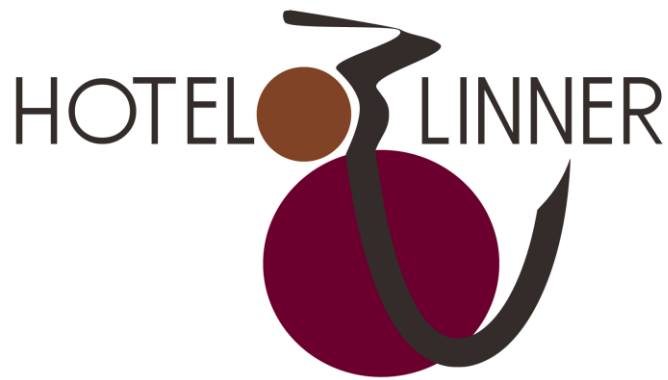

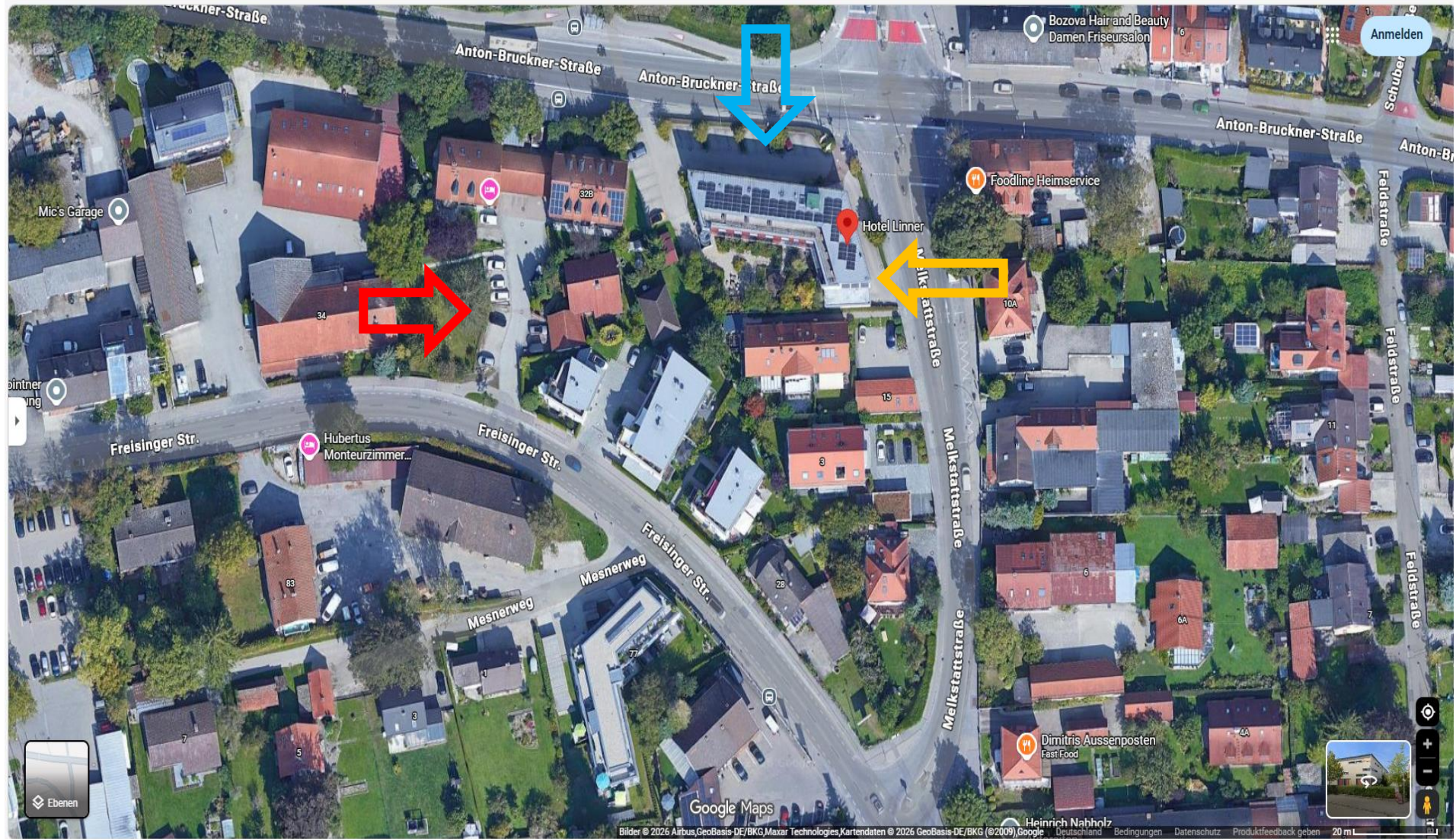

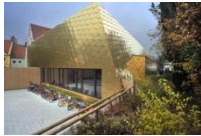

1 The beautiful small old City

- Is just a few walk minutes away from the hotel

Erding over the centuries

The history of the town Erding dates back to around 500 years in the area of today's Klettham district. At this early time, there was already proven Bavarian settlements and over the centuries, various towns and settlements have sprung up in that area – Altham was first mentioned in a document in 742, old Erding in 788, Langengeisling in 883 and Klettham around 930, before Duke Ludwig der Kelheim finally founded the town of Erding in 1228. The Wittels Bach dynasty endeavored to expand and secure his dominions, including the construction of fortified towns. Around 120 years later, in 1347, the first city expansion to include the suburb of The Hague follows. At this time the grain storage can already be attested to, due to its nationwide importance, the city of Erding becomes prosperous, because its grain storage becomes the second largest in whole of Bavaria after Munich.

Despite the construction of fortifications, the city suffered an eventful fate in the coming centuries. In 1503, for example, Duke Albrecht IV took Erding in the Landshut War of Succession. However, the city experienced its hardest time during the Thirty Years' War (1618-48). Not only do citizens repeatedly have to raise substantial war taxes; in 1632 the Swedes advanced as far as Erding and took the town by force, in 1634 the citizens fell victim to a trick of Croatian troops, the result is looting again. However, the city experienced the worst year of the war in 1648, the year of the Peace of Westphalia. French troops almost completely burn the town except for the churches and a few houses. And even in the 18th decade, Erding was not spared from disaster: after Pandours and Croats had caused serious damage to the city in the War of the Austrian Succession in 1741, a typhoid epidemic spread through the city in 1772. However, Erding was also the twelfth largest city in Bavaria at the time, contemporary authors report, and the citizens did not live in opulent prosperity, "but was sufficient to make life more beautiful.

Erding experienced its first gigantic boom in the first half of the 19th century. Causes are the thriving grain industry and the flaming trade. Ironically, the connection of the city to the railway network in 1872 caused a gradual decline in the grain storage. The two world wars shaped the history of the town of Erding in the first half of the 20th century. Although the construction of the air base in 1935/36 led to an increase in population, American attacks in April 1945 resulted in the extensive destruction of the city center and the military air base.

The municipal area reform of 1978 represents the greatest turning point in Erding's post-war history. The city is merged with the previously independent communities of old Erding and Langengeisling. In 1992, the new Munich Airport in Erding's Moss began operations. Erding is once again becoming an attractive business location, and the population is increasing sharply again. Almost 34,000 people live in the city today

5 Erding Autumn Festival – A MUST for everyone

Always starts on the last weekend in August on Friday and lasts 10 days

The history of the Erding Autumn Festival:

The Erding Autumn Festival was launched in 1816 under the name "Agricultural District Festival".



Agricultural exhibition and folk festival in Erding. The first new edition was in 1835, then again in 1860, 1864 and 1876. Real dry spells followed until 1892 (with "electric lighting of the fairground" and "various public amusements") and then again until 1904.



The Erdinger marquee from 1928. Because of the First World War, an exuberant folk festival was out of the question until 1928. The Autumn Festival has only been celebrated annually since 1949 (always for ten days starting on the last Friday in August).



The fairground in 1954. Although it was supposed to be a permanent feature in the festival calendar in 1935, the Second World War put an end to these plans.

Today well over 200,000 visitors flock to the Erdinger Volksplatz (folks square), let 1,700 hectoliters of beer run down their throats and enjoy the attractions and stalls that the third largest folk festival in Upper Bavaria has to offer.



6 Erdinger city tower tour

In the past ten years, guided tours of the city tower have become an integral part of the tourist program of the district town. The 46 meter high building with 162 steps is the oldest building in Erding and dates from the 14th century.

The tower served on the one hand as a watchtower from which the watchman kept a lookout, on the other hand (still today) as a bell tower for the parish church of St. John, although both buildings were built spatially separate from each other.

Public tours take place every third Sunday of the month. Meet at 3:30 p.m. at the entrance of the tower.

The tour lasts about an hour and costs 2 euros per person. Children up to their 12th birthday are free.

There are also guided tours to ring the bells or watch the sunset over Munich in winter.

In addition to the public tours, special tours can also be arranged or gift vouchers purchased from tower guide Doris Bauer (telephone 08122/99 98 112 or 0171/337 0065 or by email at stadtturm@t-online.de).

Bike trails in the region

Let's go, in the saddle and kicked off. Here is a little foretaste of one of the 16 signposted cycle tours in the district of Erding, which are also booked from all directions on the Bavarian long-distance cycle path network.

Vils valley cycling path

On the former route of the Dorfen - Taufkirchen (Vils) - Velden railway line, which had been closed since 1993, one of the most beautiful cycle paths in Bavaria was created in 1999/2000. After the three communities involved had acquired the land in a long-standing negotiation poker game with the Deutsche Bundesbahn in 1998, things progressed quickly, especially in Taufkirchen (Vils). In October 1999, the Taufkirchen (Vils) – Velden section was opened. A year later the route to Dorfen followed. This first section of the Vilstal cycle path, which continues from Velden via Vilsbiburg to Vilshofen, is 21 km long. Of these, 11 km run on Taufkirchener, 7 km on Dorfener and 3 km in Velden area. Since the route has only slight inclines, many families with children go on a bike trip here.

The track that is tarred all the way shared by cyclists, walkers and skaters. For the latter, the Vilstalradweg has obviously become an insider tip. In any case, when the weather is nice, you can find license plates from all over Bavaria in the parking lots along the route.

If you want to enjoy nature, you can draw from the full: The route leads past fields, vieweids and wooded areas. Between Taufkirchen (Vils) and Dorfen you have a wonderful view over the Isar valley.

Numerous rest areas with benches - in the Taufkirchen area donated primarily by the local history and beautification association - invite you to linger.

There are also several rest stop options along the route for a snack

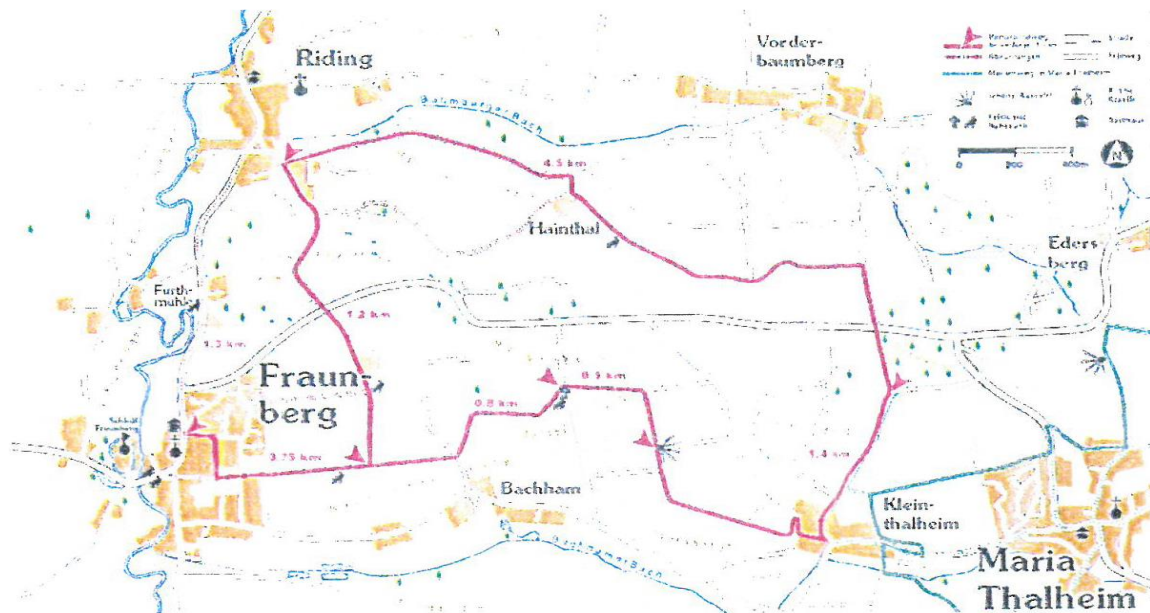
Anyone who wants to do without the car as a foreigner can travel by train to Dorfen and then set off on foot, by bike or on inline skates. We wish all users a lot of fun!



Hiking in region- Erding

An example of one the many marked hiking paths in our district, we would like to introduce you to the panoramic paths around Fraunberg.

Panoramic paths



Dear hikers from near and far, a warm welcome to the "Panorama paths" of the municipality Fraunberg.

Now we cross the street at guest house Stulberger, pass the kindergarten and turn left on the next road towards Feldfahrt. Now it goes slightly uphill to the mission cross.

Here, it is worth taking a first look back at Fraunberg and behind it the vastness of the Erdinger moss. Our panoramic path continues straight ahead to the next sign post, then we turn left to the southern edge of the "Nusshölzl", downright the valley is the village of Bachham with its lovingly restored court chapel.

Now we climb up to the Galgenberg, find another bench in front of beautiful bushes and a large cross. The name is reminiscent of an old execution site. At that time, the gallows stood a little further southeast on the hilltop. From there you can see both the house of the executioner's assistant in Bachham and Fraunberg Castle in the west. To the northwest lies the old "Urtl-Hof", the "court of judgment", in which the verdict was read out to the delinquents again before they were brought to the Galgenberg for execution.

Our path turns right immediately after the group of trees onto a field path, after about 500 m we'll reach the highest point of the panoramic path: In the east you can see the church tower of Maria Thalheim, further south the green spire of Rappoltskirchen can be seen. The view continues westwards over the villages of Grucking, Reichenkirchen, Lohkirchen and Fraunberg.

In the distance we can see Munich on a clear day. To the northwest lie Freising and the Hallertau. On the horizon we see a magnificent alpine backdrop and its cool breeze.
